COST: All classes \$50.00 for first skater; \$45.00 for any additional skaters/classes

EQUIPMENT: Students will need to have skates (no double blades) with sturdy skate boots. Rental skates are available through the rink for a fee of \$18 due at first lesson (\$3 per lesson for 6 lessons).
